Before Pentecost Sunday, bright red geraniums are given in memory of family and friends. This year, 129 geraniums were planted in the church gardens by the volunteers.

What a wonderful reminder of the first Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit came to the disciples with tongues of fire, accompanied by the sound of the rushing wind, giving them power of speaking in different languages.
